

Belmont House and Gardens Terms and Conditions

1. These terms and conditions apply to your purchase of any tickets to Belmont House and Gardens, including:
 - Garden Tickets
 - House and Garden Tickets
 - Season Tickets
 - Event and Workshop Tickets
2. Tickets are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged. Redress may only be given where Belmont House is specifically at fault.
3. Opening hours, events and offers are subject to change and at times it may be necessary to restrict access to the facilities. While we will endeavour to publicise any such change on our website, we strongly advise checking the relevant details.
4. Prices displayed on the website are subject to change without notice.
5. Your booking is valid for the date and time shown on the booking confirmation only.
6. Only the number of persons stated on the booking confirmation will be admitted to the event.
7. We reserve the right to cancel an event without reason, however in the event of this, a refund for your booking will be given, but our liability would not extend beyond this refund.
8. We reserve the right to at any point close any area within the gardens, house and estate.
9. Historic Houses members must bring their membership cards with them and sign in on arrival either in the Tack Room for gardens only and on days the house is open, in the Orangery.
10. A season ticket permits two adults and two children unlimited visits to the gardens for 12 months from the date of purchase.
11. A season ticket may only be used by the named holder and is not transferable.
12. A lost, stolen and/or damaged membership cards should be immediately reported to administrator@belmont-house.org. A new card will be issued free of charge.
13. Season tickets are not valid for separately ticketed events and workshops.
14. Children should be accompanied by an adult at all times. Please be aware that both the kitchen and walled garden contain an ornamental pond. The drive is in constant use by cars and agricultural vehicles. Please do not climb the trees and be aware of the Ha-Ha
15. Dogs are welcome in the gardens only if they are kept on a lead at all times.
